Mark Biggs holds a Bachelors and Masters in Music Education from the University of North Texas. He has worked as a writer, arranger, and clinician for the Marcus H. S. drum lines and percussion ensembles for more than 16 years. He spends his summers writing arranging and teaching percussion in the North Texas area. A former middle school and high school band director, Mark now teaches math to hard-to-reach students in Birdville ISD. Mark lives with his wife and four children in North Richland Hills, TX.

Jim Boulet is currently an assistant band director at Byron Nelson High School in Trophy Club, Texas. His duties include directing the percussion ensemble, drumline, jazz band, and assisting the Wind Ensemble and marching band. Before coming to the Northwest ISD, he taught at Grapevine H.S. and, twelve years in the Southlake Carroll I.S.D. at the middle school level. Mr. Boulet graduated with a Bachelor of Music Degree from the University of Texas at Arlington and was a member of the Sky Ryders Drum and Bugle Corps and Texas Wind Symphony. He is an active performer, educator, clinician, and adjudicator throughout North Texas.

Christopher Deane is associate professor in percussion at the University of North Texas. Prior to his appointment with UNT, he was the principal timpanist of the Greensboro Symphony for nine years and a regular performer as both percussionist and timpanist with the North Carolina Symphony for ten years. He has performed with numerous orchestras including the Cincinnati Symphony, Cincinnati Chamber Orchestra, Detroit Symphony, Minnesota Orchestra and the Spoleto Festival Orchestra.

Jon Lee is an Adjunct Lecturer of Percussion at the Meadows School of the Arts at Southern Methodist University and is the Director of the Meadows Percussion Ensemble. He is the Principal Timpanist of the Garland Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Arlington, and the Las Colinas Symphony Orchestras. He performs regularly with the Dallas Wind Symphony Plano Symphony Orchestra, and many others. Jon has been on the faculty of the University of Texas at Arlington, the Stephen F. Austin Percussion Symposium, Marimba Madness, and the Leigh Howard Stevens Pre-College Marimba Seminar. He is a member of the Percussive Arts Society and the Texas Music Educators Association. Lee holds a B.M. degree from the University of North Texas and a M.M. degree from the Meadows School of the Arts at SMU and has done post-graduate work at the University of North Texas.

Kennan Wylie holds a Bachelors and Masters degree in Music Education from the University of North Texas. He was an adjunct professor of percussion at University of Arlington for ten years and is currently the Percussion Instructor at Marcus High School in Flower Mound, Texas. Under his direction over the past several years, the Marcus group has received national acclaim both on and off the field, including nine national championship titles at the P.A.S.I.C. Marching Competition. Marcus H.S. also won the 1999 and 2003 P.A.S. "Call for Tapes". K. Wylie Publications has a full line of beginning percussionist instructional books, solos, and ensembles.
