**Mark Biggs** holds a Bachelors and Masters in Music Education from the University of North Texas. He has worked as a writer, arranger, and clinician for the Marcus H. S. drum lines and percussion ensembles for more than 16 years. He spends his summers writing arranging and teaching percussion in the North Texas area. A former middle school and high school band director, Mark now teaches math to hard-to-reach students in Birdville ISD. Mark lives with his wife and four children in North Richland Hills, TX.

**Jim Boulet** is currently in his fifteenth year of teaching, and currently teaches at Medlin Middle School in Trophy Club. At Medlin, Mr. Boulet teaches the Symphonic Band, assists with the Wind Ensemble and teaches all the beginning woodwind classes. Prior to joining the Northwest I.S.D. he was the assistant director of bands at Grapevine High School where he worked with the Honors Band, Marching Band, and Jazz Bands. From 1993-2005, he was the director of bands at Carroll Middle School in Southlake where his groups received consistent sweepstakes and Best in Class awards at various contests. Mr. Boulet graduated with a Bachelor of Music Degree from the University of Texas at Arlington and was a member of the Sky Ryders Drum and Bugle Corps and Texas Wind Symphony. He is an active performer, educator, clinician, and adjudicator throughout the North Texas area.

**Christopher Deane** is associate professor in percussion at the University of North Texas. Prior to his appointment with UNT, he was the principal timpanist of the Greensboro Symphony for nine years and a regular performer as both percussionist and timpanist with the North Carolina Symphony for ten years. He has performed with numerous orchestras including the Cincinnati Symphony, Cincinnati Chamber Orchestra, Detroit Symphony, Minnesota Orchestra and the Spoleto Festival Orchestra.

**Jon Lee** is an Adjunct Lecturer of Percussion at the Meadows School of the Arts at Southern Methodist University and is the Director of the Meadows Percussion Ensemble. He is the Principal Timpanist of the Garland Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Arlington, and the Las Colinas Symphony Orchestras. He performs regularly with the Dallas Wind Symphony Plano Symphony Orchestra, and many others. Jon has been on the faculty of the University of Texas at Arlington, the Stephen F. Austin Percussion Symposium, Marimba Madness, and the Leigh Howard Stevens Pre-College Marimba Seminar. He is a member of the Percussive Arts Society and the Texas Music Educators Association. Lee holds a B.M. degree from the University of North Texas and a M.M. degree from the Meadows School of the Arts at SMU and has done post-graduate work at the University of North Texas.

**Kennan Wylie** holds a Bachelors and Masters degree in Music Education from the University of North Texas. He was an adjunct professor of percussion at University of Arlington for ten years and is currently the Percussion Instructor at Marcus High School in Flower Mound, Texas. Under his direction over the past fourteen years, the Marcus group has received national acclaim both on and off the field, including nine national championship titles at the P.A.S.I.C.
